JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintains the security of the facility by conducting security checks, settling disputes, and performing cell searches and inspections; conducts outside perimeter checks.
- Preparation and proper completion in the documentation of inmate records.
- Issues inmate meals, clothing, linens, and personal items.
- Supervise inmate programs (recreational, legal, health care, visitation and religious services)
- Prepares reports on jail and inmate activities, enforce inmate handbook rules.
- Supervises inmates performing such assignments as cleaning and maintaining the jail facility and continuously observe locations and activities of inmates.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- High School / GED Certificate and must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen and resident of the contiguous United States for a period of time sufficient to conduct a background investigation.
- Must be able to work days, nights, weekends, holidays and mandatory shifts when needed.
- Must be able to work during natural disasters and or under declarations.
- Must possess a valid Texas driver's license and an acceptable driving record as determined by the Galveston County Sheriff's Office in effect at the time of application.
- Must have favorable employment history. All information given regarding past employment will be thoroughly checked
- Must have a stable credit history.
- Must possess good computer skills and demonstrate comprehensive reading and comprehension skills.
- No conviction above a Class B Misdemeanor or a Class B misdemeanor within the last 10 years nor have been on or currently on court-ordered community supervision or probation for any criminal offense and no Family Violence convictions of any level.
- Applicant must pass all phases of the required testing.
- Must be eligible for licensing by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) for the position applied for, if not presently licensed.
